Clare has worked at the Foundation for 7 years throughout the Victorian Parliamentary Inquiry into the handling of child abuse by religious and other organisations and the Royal Commission into Institutional Responses to Child Abuse. With this experience and a background in advocacy and social justice Clare is well placed to oversee the current increase in demand for the services of the Foundation and to steer the organisation into the future.

In Good Faith and Associates was established by Helen Last in 1997 and under her leadership became In Good Faith Foundation in 2013. IGFF is a registered charity that has thrived with the demands for services growing exponentially in recent years. IGFF continues to act as an Australia wide role model through its responses to survivors of institutional abuses in religious contexts and act as a force for social good.

Helen remains with the Foundation in the role of Principal Practitioner continuing her important work establishing advocacy and justice pathways for survivors and providing ongoing support to the Foundation.
